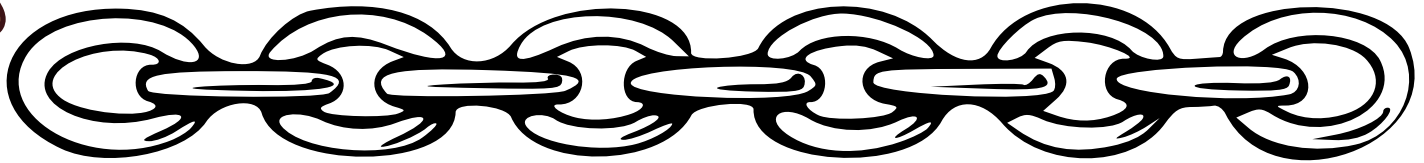




Behavior Chains

Dogs learn in Behavior "Chains" - learned links or steps, in succession - like steps of a dance.



→ "How we go outside:" - inside the mind of a dog:
